FROM THE DIRECTOR

The journey for this opera started with a word and frustration over a Trump travel ban. Afarin, the composer, had approached me about a number of projects and as we sat down to talk through them, the word forbidden came up. Apparently, it is still forbidden for women to sing in public in Iran. The word was so deep and provocative that it took over our conversation. At the same time, Trump was on a travel ban rant and, in response, we had been considering producing a show from performers with backgrounds from "banned" countries as a small way to counter the destructive forces of his racist rhetoric. Forbidden immediately felt like the right start for a Tap:Ex show and quickly the idea for integrating rap/spoken word, a genre with a great empowerment and social justice history, became the natural way forward. Donna-Michelle St. Bernard, a LIBLAB graduate and celebrated playwright who is also a powerful rapper and spoken word artist, met Afarin and the rest is here for you to see today.

FROM THE CREATORS

Inside each of us is a small child who finds it irksome to be forbidden anything, who sees things in absolutes, who is outraged by the word "no", but equally driven to do right, to please and to be liked.

It is often in the absolutes that abuses of authority occur. Increasingly, those we expect to embody moral authority discredit themselves with egregious transgressions, and unquestioning loyalty is an abdication. We have the power to evolve our ethical inheritance, to topple corrupt structures that cynically exploit, to resist our fear.

Exploring the forbidden compels us to closely consider power, punishment, oppression, as well as goodness, forgiveness and compassion. We are drawn to the idea of the Creator in us all, and to the idea that to be created in God's image is to be created with the capacity to create. With this work we embrace the sacred in ourselves, and in you.

در درون همه ی ما، کودکی است که از اینکه او را از چیزی بازدارند خوشش نمی آید. کودکی که از شنیدن "نه" بر آشفته می شود. اما به همان اندازه دوست دارد کار صحیح را انجام دهد، برای خوشایند دیگران و برای آنکه دوست داشته شود.

قالباً در مطلق است که سوء استفاده از قدرت صورت می گیرد. از برخی از آنهایی که توقع عملکرد صحیح اخلاقی داریم، بیشتر و بیشتر تخطی های رسوا کننده سر می زند که آنها را بی اعتبار می کند و به این دلیل، پیروی بی چون و چرا از آنان بی مسولیتی است. ما توانایی این را داریم که به ترسهایمان فایق بیاییم و این قدرت های سوءاستفاده گران را سرنگون سازیم.

بررسی موضوع "ممنوعه" ما را مجبور می کند تا به مفاهیم قدرت، تنبیه، سرکوب، و همچنین نیکی ، بخشایش و همدلی عمیقا توجه کنیم. ما به ایده ی "خالق درون" باور داریم و نیز به اینکه پیش نیاز خداگونه بودن قدرت آفرینندگی و خلق است.

SYNOPSIS

A child receiving spiritual instruction commits an inadvertent transgression and is punished with isolation and rote repetition. A stranger enters, encouraging the child to question the authority of her instructor by revealing the cruel realities of this world.

- With His Eyes: an interrogator objectifies then violates his female prisoner, a journalist.
- Stay Still, Forever: a penitent, having undergone conversion therapy, assures his priest that their mutual attraction is no sin.
- Book's Lament: censored, burned and banned books are given voice.
- White Key: a child terrorist considers the promise of heavenly reward.
- Playground Rules: a woman reporting her rape is arrested for violating alcohol prohibition.
- With His Serenity: an agent of the state surveils a "subversive" faith practitioner.

The stranger argues that the world's rules, laws and norms only serve to empower people to punish and abuse others. He concludes that selfishness, anarchy and sinfulness are the only sensible systems to abide by. As the child explores various authoritative texts, she learns the stranger's name: Iblis; Lucifer, the fallen angel. The child sees the sad irony that rules intended to protect society can often cause harm. She struggles to define her own beliefs against Lucifer's challenging proposition.

"Our deepest fear is not that we are inadequate. Our deepest fear is that we are powerful beyond measure. It is our light, not our darkness that most frightens us. We ask ourselves, Who am I to be brilliant, gorgeous, talented, fabulous? Actually, who are you not to be? You are a child of God. Your playing small does not serve the world. There is nothing enlightened about shrinking so that other people won't feel insecure around you. We are all meant to shine, as children do. We were born to make manifest the glory of God that is within us. It's not just in some of us; it's in everyone. And as we let our own light shine, we unconsciously give other people permission to do the same. As we are liberated from our own fear, our presence automatically liberates others." - Marianne Williamson

خلاصه داستان

کودکی (سمبلی از روح یا آگاهی انسان) در پی کشف حقیقت و کسب دانش است. بخاطر تخطی از طرف صاحبان اختیار مجازات و حبس شده و محکوم به پیروی است. شخصی مرموز سعی در تشویق کودك به زیر سؤال بردن همه چیز دارد و حقایق تلخی از زندگی اشخاص مختلف را به کودك نمایان میکند. این شخص مرموز باور دارد که قوانین و دستورات و نورمها وسیله کسب قدرت برای صاحبان قدرت است تا انسانها را تنبیه و یا از انها سواستفاده کنند.

او باور دارد خودخواهي، گناه و هرج و مرج تنها حقايق پايدارند. كودك در اين مسير ميفهمد مرد مرموز همان شيطان فرشته رانده شده (نفس اماره) است كه نامها و اشكال متفاوت دارد. سپس ياد ميگيرد باور های خود را مجددا تعريف كند و بر پا ميخيزد.

Neema Bickersteth - Child

Neema Bickersteth was born and raised in Alberta to a family from Sierra Leone, and is now based in Toronto. Bickersteth is a Canadian soprano known for her skills as a singer, an actor and a maker of multi-disciplinary performance. She has performed many operatic roles in both Canada and Europe, including Pamina from Mozart's Die Zauberflöte, the title role of Léhar's The Merry Widow and the soprano lead in Dark Star Requiem for the Luminato Festival and Tapestry Opera. Outside of opera, Neema has been honoured to perform for the XIVth Dalai Lama,

Shirin Ebadi and the Archbishop Desmond Tutu. She has received both Bachelor and Master of Music degrees (Opera) from the University of British Columbia and has been nominated for two Dora Mavor Moore awards for Outstanding Performance in Musical Theatre.



Shirin Eskandani - The woman & various

Hailed by Opera Today for her "pleasing and pliant voice" Iranian Canadian mezzo soprano, Shirin Eskandani, recently made her Metropolitan Opera stage debut as Mercedes in Carmen. She is the recipient of several prestigious awards including first place at the Gerda Lissner Foundation Vocal Competition and fourth place at the Licia Albanese-Puccini Competition. Her recent career highlights include singing Dorabella in Cosi fan Tutte, the Mezzo Soloist in the Verdi Requiem, Angelina in La Cenerentola, and Sandrina in un Avvertimento ai

Gelosi. She has performed with the Rossini Opera Festival, Merola Opera, Opera Theater of St Louis and Palm Beach Opera.

Alexander Hajek - Lucifer & various

Toronto native Baritone Alexander Hajek is currently enjoying an international career as an opera, oratorio, and rock star. His career has taken him to the arid deserts of the Middle East, frozen glaciers of the Arctic Circle and the deepest darkest rainforests of Central America. A graduate of St Michaels Choir School here in Toronto and Juilliard in New York, he is currently singing Leporello and Don Carlo in Germany. Mr. Hajek is pleased to sing with Tapestry again.



Säye Skye - The boy & various

Säye Skye is a transgender Iranian rap artist and LGBTQ rights activist at the forefront of a new hip-hop movement that has its basis in social consciousness. With astonishing originality, his experimental raps challenge deep-rooted stereotypes of misogyny, discrimination, and queerphobia. Since age 13, he has been crafting songs and poems that resonate deeply with people, using music as a platform for communicating truth. Säye Skye's work is distinguished by both its mystery and infectious energy. Using the poetic language of Farsi,

each song elicits an instant audience connection through its passion and pulse. From its unpredictable flow and hypnotic rhythms to its evocative lyrics, Säye Skye's work invites listeners to question their current state of being.

Säye Skye is the first artist in Iran's history to sing about the LGBTQ community, their existence and their protracted struggle for freedom. In 2009, he recorded and released his first single in Iran, Säye Yek Zane Irani (Shadow of an Iranian Woman). As a queer artist, he was consequently put at great risk for singing and advocating for LGBTQ rights through his music. In 2010, Säye Skye was forced to leave his home and seek asylum in Turkey, where he was granted refugee status, and moved thereafter to Toronto in March 2011. Säye Skye is currently collaborating with acclaimed German producers and singers on the release of his first EP.



Padideh Ahrarnejad - Tar

Padideh Ahrarnejad is a musician, arranger, composer and educator. A graduate of the Tehran Art Music School and the Art University of Tehran, Padideh studied tar with major figures of Persian music, including Behrouz Het mati, Hossein Alizade and Hooshang Zarif. She received the award for best tar player at Fadjr Music Festival in Iran several times. Padideh has played around the world. Since emigrating to Toronto, Canada in 2016, she has become a member of the New Canadian Global Music Orchestra.



Kianoush Khalilian - Ney

Kianoush Khalilian is a composer and a highly skilled player of the ney (Persian reed flute). He began his studies with very distinguished Iranian masters, including Hasan Nahid in 1990 in Tehran; five years later he ranked first in the nationwide Iranian school competition for ney performance. Kianoush has performed in concerts in Iran, Canada and across Europe, and has won awards for his outstanding teaching. He is about to publish his first book: a guide to learning the ney.

Ali Massoudi - Percussion

Ali Massoudi, born in Tehran in 1973, is a skilled percussionist who has trained under masters like Bijan Kamkar and Farhad Andalibi. He has collaborated with Tehran Symphony Orchestra, as well as the Iran's National Orchestra and various popular traditional bands and has also performed in several concerts in Iran, Europe, Canada, China and Cuba. He is the author of 5 educational books for tonbak, daf and udu.

He leads the Navaye Kimia Ensemble which has had many performances in Toronto and has collaborated with Andalib, Shiraz and Barg ensembles in concerts in Toronto, Ottawa and Montreal.



Afarin Mansouri - Composer

Afarin Mansouri is an award-winning composer whose works have been performed in Canada, the United States, England, Iran, and South America. She has worked with many organizations and Festivals such as You Dance National Ballet of Canada, Tirgan Festival and Toronto Nuit Blanche. Afarin is an associate composer of Canadian Music Centre and a national Councilor of the Canadian League of Composers. Also as the co-founder and Artistic Director of Iranian-Canadian Composers of Toronto (ICOT), as well as director of MUSIC NEST, she has produced

numerous concerts and music workshops for adults and children in Toronto. Currently she is at the last stages of her PhD studies at York University finishing her research on Canadian children's opera while teaching undergraduate courses in music.



Donna-Michelle St. Bernard - Librettist
Donna-Michelle St. Bernard aka Belladonna the
Blest is an emcee, playwright, librettist and
agitator. Works for the stage include Cake, Sound of
the Beast, A Man A Fish, Salome's Clothes, and Gas

through Tapestry's LibLab program. DM is emcee in
residence at Theatre Passe Muraille, playwright in
residence at lemonTree Creations and a vocalist with
